There will be a table in the foyer for the month of August, with the sign-up sheets for the available groups.

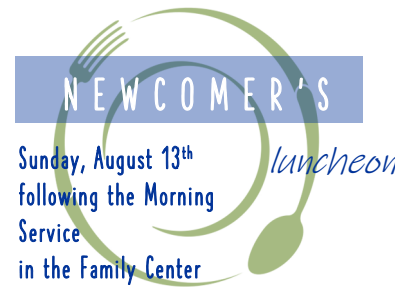
Growth Groups are 8 to 16 adults gathering to grow and serve together and study God's Word. What a blessing to gather as brothers and sisters in Christ!
